

UPDATED POLICY FOR ALL SNC EVENTS

1. **Vaccination, and providing proof of vaccination**, is now required for **ALL inside SNC activities** (Coffees, luncheons, and SIG events).
2. If a SNC member with suspected or confirmed covid has been in close contact with any SNC members, it is **her responsibility to immediately notify** the SIG chair, the person who planned the event, (if it is not the SIG chair), **and** the President of SNC.
3. With regard to SNC events that take place outside it is recommended that current CDC guidelines are followed, with our recommendation that they be vaccinated, and if not, to encourage social distancing, and wearing a mask.
4. **Prior to attending any SNC event**, (inside or outside), a member (or guest) **should not attend if:**
 - a) Feeling ill, or having a cough, sore throat, temperature, etc.
 - b) Having been exposed to someone who had covid
5. Any member who holds a SNC event in her own home has the prerogative to set any additional requirements that she feels are necessary (masks, food stipulations, etc.)
